### A day on the water during the Americas Cup.



On 14 March 2021 a day aboard the historic steam tug, the William C Daldy has been organised to coincide with the Americas Cup racing, in the hope that we might see one or two races. However, this is not guaranteed so it could just be a nice day on the water socialising, with a BBQ dinner aboard and the prospect of a swim.

The Daldy can carry 115 passengers. We are in the first instance inviting IYFR members with their friends and family as guests, to pay before the 14 February at a cost of \$90.00 per person, on a first come first served basis. After the 14 Feb, if we do not have a full boat, we will open it up to Rotarians at \$100 per head, again on a first come first served basis. To have a day like this on a commercial boat during the Americas Cup would cost many times this amount.

Drinks; There is a cash bar on board. Prices are very reasonable: Local beer \$5. Wine by the glass \$6, imported beers \$7 plus there is juice, tea and coffee etc. Please no BYO – it has a high corkage charge which IYFR will not cover.

Payment: Would IYFR members please pay for themselves and their guests by online payment to the IYFR Auckland Fleet bank account 12-3026-0393942-00 **stating their Name, number in their party and 'Daldy'**, before the 14 Feb. After this the price goes to \$100.

Should COVID restrictions be implemented, the 'Daldy' sailing could be cancelled or still operate, but with a lower capacity. We will manage this according to the situation.
